1 Florida (3-0)

Yesterday: def. Tennessee, 23-13

The game: Tim Tebow ran for 76 yards and a touchdown and Caleb Sturgis kicked three field goals as the Gators beat the Vols. Next: at Kentucky, Saturday.



2 Texas (2-0)

Yesterday: vs. Texas Tech, late

The game: With 654 yards passing in his first two games, QB Colt McCoy has surpassed 10,000 yards for his career with 10,386. Next: vs. UTEP, Saturday.



3 Southern California (2-1)

Yesterday: lost to Washington, 16-13

The game: Erik Folk kicked a 22-yard field goal with three seconds left and the Huskies' defense stymied the USC offense. Next: vs. Washington State, Saturday.



4 Alabama (3-0)

Yesterday: def. North Texas, 53-7

The game: Greg McElroy passed for two touchdowns and rushed for another and the Crimson Tide rolled over Mean Green. Next: vs. Arkansas, Saturday.



5 Penn State (3-0)

Yesterday: def. Temple, 31-6

The game: Evan Royster ran for 134 yards and a touchdown, and the Nittany Lions revived their rushing attack against the Owls. Next: vs. Iowa, Saturday.



5 Mississippi (2-0)

Yesterday: def. SE Louisiana, 52-6

The game: Jevan Snead threw three touchdowns and Brandon Bolden rushed for 105 yards to pace the Rebels. Next: at South Carolina, Thursday.



7 BYU (2-1)

Yesterday: lost to Florida State, 54-28

The game: Christian Ponder threw for two touchdowns and ran for another and the Seminoles ended the Cougars' 18-game home winning streak. Next: vs. Colorado State, Saturday.



8 California (3-0)

Yesterday: def. Minnesota, 35-21

The game: Jahvid Best rushed for 131 yards and a school-record five touchdowns to lift the Golden Bears over the Gophers. Next: at Oregon, Saturday.



9 LSU (3-0)

Yesterday: def. Louisiana-Lafayette, 31-3

The game: Chad Jones had two interceptions to lead a dominant performance by the Tigers. Next: at Mississippi State, Saturday.



10 Boise State (3-0)

Yesterday: did not play

The game: RB Jeremy Avery had 269 yards of offense in a wild, 51-34 victory Friday vs. Fresno State. There were eight scoring drives of three plays or less. Next: at Bowling Green, Saturday.



11 Ohio State (2-1)

Yesterday: def. Toledo, 38-0

The game: Terrelle Pryor threw two early touchdowns to Dane Sanzenbacher and the Buckeyes defused Toledo's high-scoring spread attack to beat the Rockets. Next: vs. Illinois, Saturday.



12 Oklahoma (2-1)

Yesterday: def. Tulsa, 45-0

The game: Landry Jones set a school record with six touchdown passes and the Sooners' defense recorded its second shutout in a row. Next: at Miami, Oct. 3.



13 Virginia Tech (2-1)

Yesterday: def. Nebraska, 16-15

The game: Tyrod Taylor threw an 11-yard touchdown pass to Dyrrell Roberts with 21 seconds left to lift the Hokies over the Cornhuskers. Next: vs. Miami, Saturday.



14 Georgia Tech (2-1)

Yesterday: Did not play

The game: The Yellow Jackets' triple option was held to 95 yards in a 33-17 Atlantic Coast Conference loss to Miami Thursday night. Next: vs. North Carolina, Saturday.



15 TCU (2-0)

Yesterday: def. Texas State, 56-21

The game: Joseph Turner ran for 129 yards and three touchdowns and Jerry Hughes had three sacks to lead the Horned Frogs. Next: at Clemson, Saturday.



16 Oklahoma State (2-1)

Yesterday: def. Rice, 41-24

The game: Zac Robinson rushed for one touchdown and threw two touchdown passes to Dez Bryant as Cowboys rebounded from last week's loss to Houston. Next: vs. Grambling State, Saturday.



17 Cincinnati (3-0)

Yesterday: def. Oregon State, 28-18

The game: Tony Pike threw for 332 yards and hit Mardy Gilyard with an 18-yard TD pass in the fourth quarter to halt the Beavers' comeback bid. Next: vs. Fresno State, Saturday.



18 Utah (2-1)

Yesterday: def. Oregon, 31-24

The game: LaMichael James rushed for 152 yards and a touchdown, and John Boyett made a crucial interception to help the Ducks top the Utes. Next: vs. Louisville, Saturday.



19 Nebraska (2-1)

Yesterday: lost to Virginia Tech, 16-15

The game: The Cornhuskers lost for the 21st time in their past 22 games against teams ranked in the Top 20. Next: vs. La.-Lafayette, Saturday.



20 Miami (2-0)

Yesterday: did not play

The game: QB Jacory Harris turned in his second big effort, going 20 of 25 for 270 yards and three TDs in a 33-17 victory vs. Georgia Tech Thursday. Next: at Virginia Tech, Saturday.



21 Houston (2-0)

Yesterday: did not play

The game: A weekend off to rest up. The Cougars will need it considering the scorefest that can be anticipated next weekend when they face Texas Tech. Next: vs. Texas Tech, Saturday.



22 Kansas (3-0)

Yesterday: def. Duke, 44-6

The game: Todd Reesing threw three touchdown passes and Maxwell Onyegbule returned an interception 48 yards for another score. Next: vs. Southern Mississippi, Saturday.



23 Georgia (1-1)

Yesterday: at Arkansas, late

The game: Bulldogs defeated South Carolina last week, 41-37, but offense still wasn't clicking as 308 total yards will attest. Next: vs. Arizona State, Saturday.



24 North Carolina (3-0)

Yesterday: def. East Carolina, 31-17

The game: Erik Highsmith had six catches for 113 yards and a touchdown and the Tar Heels compiled 433 total yards. Next: at Georgia Tech, Saturday.



25 Michigan (3-0)

Yesterday: def. Eastern Michigan, 45-17

The game: Carlos Brown had a 90-yard touchdown run and a career-high 187 yards rushing to help the Wolverines past the Eagles. Next: vs. Indiana, Saturday.
