**Yesterday:** def. South Carolina, 24-14  
**The game:** Tim Tebow tied the Southeastern Conference TD record and the Gators gained their first perfect conference record in 13 years. Next: vs. Florida International, Saturday.

**Yesterday:** def. Baylor, 47-14  
**The game:** Colt McCoy tied the NCAA record for career victories by a starting quarterback and threw two touchdown passes to help the Longhorns stay undefeated. Next: vs. Kansas, Saturday.

**Yesterday:** def. Mississippi State, 31-3  
**The game:** Mark Ingram rushed for 149 yards and two touchdowns and Greg McElroy threw two long scoring passes. Next: vs. Chattanooga, Saturday.

**Yesterday:** vs. Utah, late  
**The game:** Horned Frogs are known for their defense, but QB Andy Dalton has posted some big numbers (18 touchdown passes, 162.7 QB Rating). Next: at Wyoming, Saturday.

**Yesterday:** Did not play  
**Of note:** Two completions, two touchdown passes for senior quarterback Tony Pike vs. WVU Friday night after missing four games with a forearm injury. Next: vs. Illinois, Nov. 27.

**Yesterday:** def. Idaho, 63-25  
**The game:** Kellen Moore threw four touchdown passes to Austin Pettis and tied a career high with five overall as the Broncos routed the Vandals. Next: at Utah State, Friday.

**7** Georgia Tech (10-1)  
**Yesterday:** def. Duke, 49-10  
**The game:** Jonathan Dwyer rushed for 110 yards and two touchdowns and Josh Nesbitt accounted for three scores. Next: vs. Georgia, Nov. 28.

**Yesterday:** vs. Notre Dame, late  
**The game:** The Panthers moved into the top 10 of The Associated Press poll this week for the first time since 1982. Next: at West Virginia, Nov. 27.

**Yesterday:** def. Louisiana Tech, 24-16  
**The game:** Keiland Williams ran for 116 yards and two second-half touchdowns, helping the Tigers fend off the upset-minded Bulldogs. Next: at Mississippi, Saturday.



**Yesterday:** def. Iowa, 27-24  
**The game:** Backup kicker Devin Barclay kicked a 39-yard field goal in overtime and the Buckeyes are going to the Rose Bowl for the first time in 13 years. Next: at Michigan, Saturday.

**11** Southern California (7-3)  
**Yesterday:** lost to Stanford, 55-21  
**The game:** Matt Barkley threw three INTs, including one that was returned for a touchdown, and the Trojans lost to Stanford at home for the second time in three years. Next: vs. UCLA, Nov. 28.

**12** Miami (7-3)  
**Yesterday:** def. North Carolina, 33-24  
**The game:** Kendrick Burney returned one of his three interceptions for a 77-yard touchdown to help the Tar Heels upset the Hurricanes. Next: vs. Duke, Saturday.

**Yesterday:** def. Central Florida, 37-32  
**The game:** Brynn Harvey rushed for 139 yards and three touchdowns, and the Knights pulled off the upset in Orlando, Fla. Next: vs. Memphis, Saturday.

**Yesterday:** vs. Arizona State, late  
**The game:** Freshman RB LaMichael James entered the weekend second in the Pac-10 in rushing with 1,043 yards and eight touchdowns. Next: at Arizona, Saturday.

**Yesterday:** lost at Ohio State, 27-24  
**The game:** The Hawkeyes scored two touchdowns in the fourth quarter to tie the score, but they failed to score in overtime. Next: vs. Minnesota, Saturday.

**Yesterday:** at TCU, late  
**The game:** True freshman QB Jordan Wynn was expected to make his second career start in one of the biggest games of the Mountain West season. Next: vs. San Diego State, Saturday.

**Yesterday:** vs. Texas Tech, late  
**The game:** The Cowboys' defense had surrendered 101 points to pass-happy Texas Tech in their past two meetings. Next: vs. Colorado, Thursday.

**Yesterday:** lost to California, 24-16  
**The game:** Shane Vereen scored on a 61-yard run and Giorgio Tavecchio kicked four field goals to help the Bears top the Wildcats. Next: vs. Oregon, Saturday.

**19** Penn State (9-2)  
**Yesterday:** def. Indiana, 31-20  
**The game:** Linebacker Navorro Bowman had a momentum-turning 73-yard interception return for a touchdown and Evan Royster scored twice. Next: at Michigan State, Saturday.

**20** Virginia Tech (7-3)  
**Yesterday:** def. Maryland, 36-9  
**The game:** Tyrod Taylor threw for 268 yards and a career-high three TDs and Ryan Williams scored his 12th TD, a single-season record for a freshman. Next: vs. North Carolina State, Saturday.

**21** Wisconsin (8-2)  
**Yesterday:** def. Michigan, 45-24  
**The game:** Scott Tolzien tied a career high with four touchdown passes and scored on a sneak to pace the Badgers. Next: at Northwestern, Saturday.

**22** BYU (8-2)  
**Yesterday:** def. New Mexico, 24-19  
**The game:** Max Hall passed for two touchdowns and got his 29th victory at BYU to match Heisman Trophy winner Ty Detmer's school record. Next: vs. Air Force, Saturday.

**23** South Florida (6-3)  
**Yesterday:** Did not play  
**Of note:** The Bulls managed only 159 yards offense in a 31-0 loss to Rutgers Thursday — the first regular-season shutout of the Bulls in the program's 13-season history. Next: vs. Louisville, Saturday.

**24** Clemson (7-3)  
**Yesterday:** def. North Carolina State, 43-23  
**The game:** C.J. Spiller became the first player in Clemson history to record a touchdown passing, rushing and receiving in the same game. Next: vs. Virginia, Saturday.

**25** Stanford (7-3)  
**Yesterday:** def. Southern California, 55-21  
**The game:** Toby Gerhart rushed for 178 yards and three touchdowns and the Cardinal beat the Trojans at the Coliseum for the second time in three years. Next: vs. California, Saturday.
