**Ohio State:** def. Michigan, 21-10 ... Terrelle Pryor finished 9 of 17 with a TD and an interception, off a deflection, and ran for 74 yards. Next: at Rose Bowl, Jan. 1.

**Iowa:** def. Minnesota, 12-0 ... James Vandenberg threw for 117 yards and fellow freshman Brandon Wegher ran for a TD. Next: Bowl, TBA.

**Penn State:** def. Michigan State, 42-14 ... Daryll Clark threw four TDs, setting the school record with 23 TD passes in a season and 42 in a career. Next: Bowl, TBA.

**Wisconsin:** lost to Northwestern, 33-31 ... Scott Tolzien was 19 of 30 for 235 yards but threw an interception with 42 seconds to go. Next: at Hawaii, Dec. 5.

**Northwestern:** def. Wisconsin, 33-31 ... Mike Kafka had his fifth 300-yard passing game of the season, going 26 of 40 for 326 yards. Next: Bowl, TBA.

**Michigan State:** lost to Penn State, 42-14 ... Kirk Cousins completed 16 of 28 passes for 155 yards with one TD and two interceptions. Next: Bowl, TBA.

**Purdue:** def. Indiana, 38-21 ... Joey Elliott threw for a career-high four TDs, and Jaycen Taylor ran for a season-best 110 yards on 20 carries. Next: Season over.

**Minnesota:** lost to Iowa, 12-0 ... Adam Weber was 14 of 40 for 153 yards for the Gophers, who have scored seven points in their past three road games. Next: TBA.

**Illinois:** did not play ... After accounting for nearly 4,000 yards in 2008, QB Juice Williams has accounted for only 1,523 this season. Next: at Cincinnati, Fri.

**Michigan:** lost to Ohio State, 21-10 ... Tate Forcier threw four interceptions, including three in the fourth quarter, and fumbled in his end zone. Next: Season over.

**Indiana:** lost to Purdue, 38-21 ... Darius Willis ran for 142 yards and Mitchell Evans caught 10 passes for 112 yards for the Hoosiers. Next: Season over.
