Re: Recent Unwarranted Publicity Regarding Morgantown Operations

Dear colleagues and members of the Mylan family:

We are writing to you today, together, to address a few points about the misleading attacks in recent days that were made against our Morgantown-based manufacturing operations and you, our colleagues and employees.

We are immensely proud of our tradition of quality and excellence in manufacturing that all of you have built over the past decades. The hard work and loyal efforts of Mylan's people, regardless whether they are union, non-union or management is what has allowed this company to grow, to succeed, and to prosper.

As our Chairman and CEO, Robert Coury stated publicly over the weekend, product quality and patient safety remain Mylan's first priority. We will never waver from the exceptional commitment to quality that all of you continue to demonstrate. This is something that has never changed about Mylan. As you know, our co-founder Mike Puskar has always insisted that we do things right, or we won't do them at all.

The recent attacks against Mylan have come not only from outside the company but also, unfortunately, from inside. Some seem not to share our commitment to excellence and instead seek to tear down what you have worked so long and so tirelessly to achieve. We will always be open to honest and fair criticism, and in fact we welcome a continual dialogue about how we can do what we do better. We cannot however tolerate unfounded attacks and negativity based on misrepresentations. As a result, we are asking all Morgantown employees to be vigilant against unauthorized disclosures of company information, inappropriate communications with outsiders or any other similar misconduct, and to report such immediately to the Office of Corporate Compliance. We need to stand together now to defend what we all know is an excellent company with an unsurpassed track record of quality and manufacturing excellence.
